Scope of Policy

This policy deals with ad hoc requests for funding made to Community Boards. It does not include Service Delivery Contracts that may be funded through a Community Board.

Eligibility

The eligibility criteria are based on two principles: -

- (a) The Principle of Strategic Fit
Applications for Community Board Grants will only be considered if the funding relates to activities/projects that are in accord with Council's Strategic Directions.
- (b) The Principle of Public Benefit
Applications for Community Board Grants will only be considered from community groups or individuals that can demonstrate that the activities/projects will result in a public benefit, primarily to residents of the relevant Community Board area.

Groups will only be eligible for Community Board Grants if they have not received any other Council grant or Fee abatement for Community Assistance in that financial year.

Projects will not be funded in retrospect.

Financial Statements should be provided if the group has been in existence for more than one year.

Accountability

Recipients of funds should fulfill the appropriate accountability requirements before the grant is paid out. This will consist of a receipt for funds received and confirmed that the funds have been used for the purpose stated in the application.

Reporting

Details of applications will be entered in the Community Assistance Grants database, whether successful or not.
