








A LONG or STRONG earthquake could be your only warning.

LONG or STRONG: GET GONE



DO NOT ignore these natural warning signs:

- Strong earthquake where it is hard to stand up.
- Weak, rolling earthquake shaking for longer than a minute.
 - Unusual sea behaviour, like sudden sea level changes.
- The sea making loud and unusual sounds, especially roaring noises.

WHAT TO DO?

- 1 Leave immediately, don't wait for an official warning.
- Walk or bike quickly if possible. Only drive if you have to.
- Move quickly to higher ground, or as far from the coastline as possible.

ZONE AND LOW-LYING AREAS UNTIL YOU GET THE ALL CLEAR FROM OFFICIAL CHANNELS STAY OUT OF THE TSUNAMI EVACUATION
