CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, and supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours: Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm;
- No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day;
- 3. No alcohol may be sold other than
 - a. beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - b. mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or

 - d. grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - e. a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted;
- 4. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons at no cost from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
- A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty, at or nearby the point of sale, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
- The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point-of-sale signage detailing the restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance to the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- The "single alcohol area" for the premises is as described on the plan dated 9 June 2020 and attached at Appendix 'A' to the licence. The licensee must ensure that:
 - a. No alcohol is displayed, promoted or advertised outside the single alcohol area; and
 - b. No products other than alcohol, low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beer, wine or mead are displayed, promoted or advertised inside the single alcohol area.

The business is a franchised supermarket and meets the criteria of s.32(1)(e) of the Act in that it is retail premises of more than 1000 square metres.

The entire premises is undesignated and there is a well-defined and compliant Single Alcohol Area (SAA). There is good visibility into the premises, and they operate a comprehensive training programme and CCTV system.

The current days and hours of operation are **Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm.** These hours are within the operative Tauranga and Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy as it pertains to off-licensed supermarkets.

No changes are sought.

Public Notification:

The application was notified in the BOP Times on the 17th and 24th of June 2020. No objections from the public were received by the secretariat.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Inspector reports that the applicant has operated this supermarket compliantly over the renewal period.

He also advises that the amenity and good order of the locality has not been reduced by more than a minor extent.

Neither the Police, nor the Medical Officer of Health, raise any matters in opposition.

The Medical Officer of Health has 'highly recommended' that the licensee does not stock 0% alcohol on the ends of aisles as they look like full strength alcohol and are close to the entrance to the store.

The single alcohol area is technically compliant, as the MOoH acknowledges, and we have no control over what the company does outside the SAA though we do note that many other similar premises place soft drinks and chips and nibbles on their ends of aisles. Maybe that is something General Distributors might want to reflect upon.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act.

We also refresh the licence conditions to reflect best practice.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contains all the supporting documents as required under s.127 of the Act. It was duly advertised and no objection, opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received.

The Police and Medical Officer of Health offer no matters in opposition.

Section 214 requires that a certificated manager be on duty at all times, unless s 215 applies. Section 215 provides a range of exceptions, where a manager does not need to be "physically on duty at all times when alcohol is being sold or supplied to the public..." and this includes off-licence premises endorsed under s40 as remote sellers.

However, the DLC holds an overarching discretion to require a Manager to be "on duty at all times" under section 215(4) if we think the prevailing circumstances require it.

In relation to this application the Committee is satisfied that the operation will be low risk, and not one which would require a manager to be on duty at all times when alcohol is sold for remote delivery.

The licensee must have a certificated manager properly appointed to the business, but, pursuant to sections 214 and 215, that manager does not need to be physically on duty at all times.

Overall, I am satisfied that the applicant carries out the business of a remote seller of alcohol and of the matters to which we must have regard as set out in the Act.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.
