

Renewal of On Licence

Sections 14 to 16, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **THE ADDRESS INDIAN KITCHEN LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **SHOP 4, 168 ŌMOKOROA ROAD, ŌMOKOROA** and known as **THE ADDRESS INDIAN KITCHEN**, to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. No alcohol is to be sold on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person who is not:
 - a. Present on the premises to dine.
2. Alcohol may only be sold on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday - 10.00 am to 11.00 pm
3. Drinking water must be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times that the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
5. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all time when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
6. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
7. A properly appointed Certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
8. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol.
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- a. until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- b. if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence replaces licence no. 022/ON/7894/2020 and this licence continues in force until 18 June 2024 unless again renewed.

This is an application by **THE ADDRESS INDIAN KITCHEN LIMITED** for the renewal of an **ON LICENCE** in respect of premises situated at **SHOP 4, 168 ŌMOKOROA ROAD, ŌMOKOROA**, known as **THE ADDRESS INDIAN KITCHEN.** The current licence has an expiry date of 18th June 2021.

The applicant is a private limited company incorporated on 14 March 2019. The business has been trading at this premises since 29 April 2019. The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a **ON LICENCE - CLASS 3 RESTAURANT.**

Days and hours sought:

Monday to Sunday **10:00 am** **to** **11:00 pm**

No changes being sought from the existing licence are sought. There have been no matters raised in regard to the Resource Management Act. The criteria found at section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) applies to this application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The renewal application was publicly notified in the Bay of Plenty Times on the 26th May 2021. No objections have been received by the Secretariat from the public.

The principal entrance is accessed from: 168 Ōmokoroa Road, Ōmokoroa. Although the applicant has requested a supervised area in front of the serving counter, the premises operates as a restaurant, with the predominant business being the sale of food and not the sale of alcohol therefore no designated areas are required.

The Inspector has reported that there are no concerns regarding the operation of the premises and no concerns have been reported from the agencies regarding the conduct of the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol on the premises.

The licensed area consists of 9 tables and the addition of another two tables out the front of the restaurant. The service of alcohol is to the table only.

Neither the Police, nor the Medical Officer of Health have raised any matters in opposition to the application.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** the application by **The Address Indian Kitchen Limited** for the renewal of



the On-Licence in respect of premises situated at **Shop 4, 168 Ōmokoroa Road, Ōmokoroa** and known as "The Address Indian Restaurant" subject to conditions.

The licensed area is more precisely defined on the plan date stamped as received by Western Bay of Plenty District Council on 2 June 2021. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.

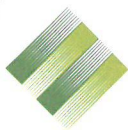
The licence is for three (3) years from the expiry of the current licence and a replacement licence is to be issued.

Section 21 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **ŌMOKOROA BOWLING CLUB INCORPORATED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **30 HAMURANA ROAD, ŌMOKOROA** and known as **ŌMOKOROA BOWLING CLUB** for consumption on the premises, to any person who –

- a. is a member of the club; or
- b. is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or

- 3. Alcohol can be sold and supplied to members of clubs with which the licensee has an arrangement for reciprocal visiting rights for members.
- 4. While the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol no BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.
- 5. At all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol a range of substantive food must be readily available. A minimum of three types of food should be available on the premises. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
- 6. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all time when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
- 7. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises;

THE APPLICATION

This is an application by **ŌMOKOROA BOWLING CLUB INCORPORATED** for the renewal of a **CLUB LICENCE** in respect of premises situated at **30 HAMURANA ROAD, ŌMOKOROA**, known as **ŌMOKOROA BOWLING CLUB.**

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a Club Licence - Class 3. The Club has 107 members over the age of 18 years.

The applicant is an incorporated society and is incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 on 2 July 1968 and has held a Club licence since 1991.

The application was publicly notified in the Katikati Advertiser on the 3rd of June 2021. No objections were received from members of the public.

No changes are sought to the existing authorised hours which are:

Sunday to Thursday	9:00 am	to	10:00 pm
Friday and Saturday	9:00am	to	1:00 am the following day.

These hours are within the operative Tauranga and Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy as it relates to Club Licences.

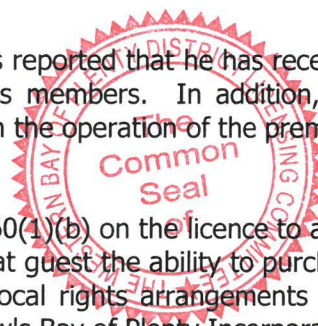
The applicant has supplied a list of food options as well as low and non-alcoholic beverages that are available when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health has raised any matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The principal activity is that of a bowling club. The Inspector has reported that he has received no complaints regarding the club activities or the actions of its members. In addition, the Inspector reports that to date, no issues have been identified with the operation of the premises in accordance with the object of the Act.

The applicant has not requested an additional condition under s.60(1)(b) on the licence to allow an authorised visitor to invite a guest into the premises giving that guest the ability to purchase alcohol. However, under s60(3)(c), the applicant shares reciprocal rights arrangements with bowling clubs within the Bay of Plenty area facilitated through Bowls Bay of Plenty Incorporated.



Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act.
