

## On Licence

*Sections 14 to 16, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012*

**Pursuant** to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **TE PUKE THAI LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **47 JELICOE STREET, TE PUKE** and known as **THAI STAR RESTAURANT & BAR**, to any person for consumption on the premises and to let people consume alcohol there.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

### **CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may only be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises on the following days and during the following hours: **Monday to Sunday: Hours: 11.00 am to 12.00am midnight**
2. No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person other than a person who is on the premises to dine;
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
4. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all time when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted;
6. A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises;
7. The Licensee must provide information, advice, and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises; and
8. The Licensee must display:
  - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
  - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
  - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.

### **DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- a. either—
  - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- b. if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either—
  - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
  - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

**THE APPLICATION**

This is an application, submitted by **TE PUKE THAI LTD**, seeks a new **ON LICENCE** in respect of premises situated at **47 JELlicOE STREET, TE PUKE**, to be known as **THAI STAR RESTAURANT & BAR**. Its principal entrance is accessed the footpath of Jellicoe Street Te Puke.

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a **ON LICENCE - CLASS 3 RESTAURANT**.

Days and hours sought are **Monday to Sunday 11.00a.m. to 12.00a.m.**

The application has resulted from the establishment of a new business on an existing café. The premises at 47 Jellicoe Street are currently unlicensed.

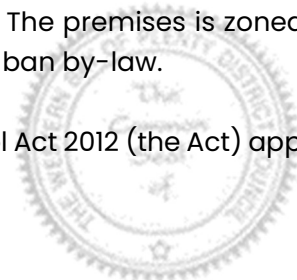
The applicant is a private limited company, **Te Puke Thai Limited**, incorporated on 27 January 2022 recently purchased the cafe that was known as Ella's Café in Te Puke. Parminder Singh is the sole director of the company and is a 50% shareholder with Nimisha Taneja. The applicant also owns a Sushi shop and Vasey's Indian Restaurant in Te Puke which currently holds an On-licence.

The premises is situated within main Te Puke shopping centre. The premises is zoned as commercial under the district plan and is subject to an alcohol ban by-law.

The criteria found at section 105 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) applies to this application.

**REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

The application was publicly notified in the Bay of Plenty Times on the 26<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2022. No public objections were made during the objection period.

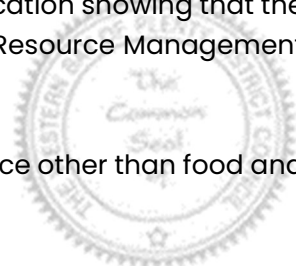


The Medical Officer of Health reported on the application on 30 June 2022 and does not oppose the application.

Police when reporting on the application (23 May 2022) did not oppose the application but raised a concern in regard to insufficient duty managers present to cover the hours to be worked. The Inspector has since spoken with the applicant regarding these concerns and now understand that Taneja (the other shareholder) will be managing the Thai restaurant when it opens from 4.30pm to 9.30 each day. As the business picks up, he will then hire another qualified manager and open for longer hours.

Based on the information provided in the application and an inspection of the premises, the Inspector considers the applicant's proposal for the sale and supply of alcohol is consistent with the purpose of the Act and meets the criteria under section 105 of the Act reporting that.

- During a general discussion held with the applicant's director on 25 May 2022 regarding the management and operation of the restaurant the applicant appeared to be aware of their responsibilities under the Act. Likewise, the applicant appears to have appropriate systems, staff, and training to comply with the law. Thereby, the Inspector reports he has no grounds to question the applicant's suitability at this point in time.
- The applicant is experienced in the hospitality industry and is well aware that he will be required to display signage relating to minors and intoxication and that the duty managers name must be displayed. Noting that at the time the Inspector carried out an inspection of the premises the renovations had not been completed with the 100f not issued, the restaurant was not trading. However, the site notice was attached to the front window that could be easily read by the public.
- The licensed area is the entire floor of the restaurant and more precisely defined on the plan attached to the electronic application received by Western Bay of Plenty District Council on 17 May 2022. The Inspector does not have concerns with the design and layout of the premises.
- A planning and building certificate were attached to the application showing that the proposed use of the premises meets the requirements of the Resource Management Act 1991 and the Building Code.
- The applicant does not intend to offer any other goods or service other than food and drink.
- The Inspector is not aware of any concerns relating to noise, nuisance or vandalism relating to licensed restaurant premises in the area and there are no visual evidence of anti-social behaviour such as discarded bottles, cans, or litter to indicate the parking facilities are being used to pre-load. Nor is there any information to suggest the premises are associated with criminal behaviour. Thereby under new management and with the addition of an on licence, there is no reason to believe the



amenity and good order of the locality would likely to be increased, by more than a minor extent, by the effects of a refusal to renew the licence.

Thereby the Inspector having carried out due diligence into the application and based on the information provided reports that the application meets the criteria of the Act.

The hours comply with the requirements of the Local Alcohol Policy, as it applies to the premises.

Subject to no new or contrary evidence being presented this application is therefore consistent with the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and the purpose of the Act therein meeting the criteria at Section 131 of the Act.

### **The Decision**

Thereby the District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, grants an application submitted by **Te Puke Thai Limited** for a **new Class 3 On-Licence** in respect to premises situated at **47 JELICOE STREET, TE PUKE**, and to trade as **Thai Star Restaurant & Bar**; subject to the following conditions.

- (a) Alcohol may only be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises on the following days and during the following hours:  
**Monday to Sunday: Hours: 11.00 am to 12.00am midnight**
- (b) No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day, or before 1 pm on Anzac Day to any person other than a person who is on the premises to dine;
- (c) Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
- (d) The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all time when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
- (e) Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted;

  - (b) At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
  - (c) A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.

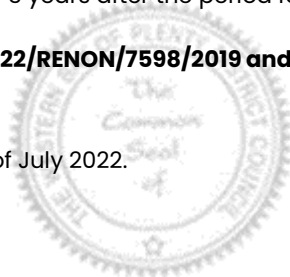

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of an **ON LICENCE - CLASS 3 RESTAURANT**.

Days and Hours sought are **Monday to Sunday 10.00a.m. to 01.00a.m.**

**TSINGH LIMITED** is a private limited company, incorporated on 21 March 2013 (No. 4358498). The company has two directors namely Manju Saini and Takdeer Singh; both 50% shareholders.

The premises is situated within the main shopping centre of Katikati township. The restaurant is in a small set back off the main road that has a number of other commercial premises operating. The premises is zoned as commercial under the district plan and is subject to an alcohol ban by-law. Its principal entrance is accessed from the main public footpath associated with Main Road, Katikati.

The café has historically been regarded as a low-risk premises and qualifies as a Class 3 restaurant.

The applicant does not seek any changes to the licence.

The criteria found at section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) applies to this application.



## **REASONS FOR THE DECISION**

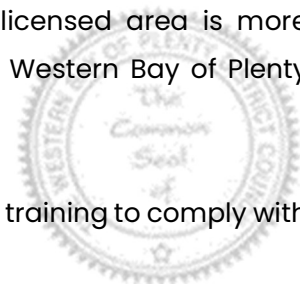
The application was publicly notified in the Katikati Advertiser on the 28 April 2022 with no objections received by expiry date 17<sup>th</sup> May 2022.

Police reported on the application on 12 May 2022 with no opposition to the granting of this renewal.

The Medical Officer of Health reported on the application on 16 May 2022 with no matters in opposition to the renewal of this licence.

The Inspector reports that based on the information provided in the application and from an inspection of the premises, he considers the applicant's proposal for the sale and supply of alcohol is consistent with the purpose of the Act and meets the criteria under section 131 of the Act and reporting that:

- A general discussion was had with the applicant's director on 25 May 2022 regarding the management and operation of the restaurant. The applicant appears to be aware of their responsibilities under the Act and there are no grounds to question the applicant's suitability at this point-in-time. When visiting the premises appropriate signage was clearly displayed including a host responsibility policy. Low and non-alcoholic beverages were available. Alternative transportation had been considered in the form of taxi information.
- No concerns have been reported from the agencies regarding the operation and conduct of the premises whilst the premises has been operating during the past renewal period.
- There have been no issues raised regarding the Building Code or the Resource Management Act.
- He has no concerns with the layout of the premises. The licensed area is more precisely defined on the plan date stamped as received by Western Bay of Plenty District Council on 13 April 2022.
- The applicant appears to have appropriate systems, staff, and training to comply with the law as indicated on their application.
- No other goods or services were observed, other than food and beverages.





- He is not aware of any concerns relating to noise, nuisance or vandalism relating to licensed premises in the area. And there are no negative reports from the police regarding the operations of the cafe and no visual signs of crime in the local vicinity. There is no information to suggest the premises are associated with criminal behaviour.
- These premises have operated for a number of years and there is no reason to believe the amenity and good order of the locality would likely to be increased, by more than a minor extent, by the effects of a refusal to renew the licence.
- The application implies there are two duty managers recorded as working for the premises. The director is responsible for training needs, which is primarily conducted by the experienced duty managers.

Therefore the Inspector, after carrying out due diligence into the application and based on the information provided, reports that the application meets the criteria in the Act recommending that this licence be renewed.

The hours comply with the requirements of the Local Alcohol Policy, as it applies to the premises.

Subject to no new or contrary evidence being presented this application is therefore consistent with the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 and the purpose of the Act therein meeting the criteria at Section 131 of the Act.
