 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

The Application



The business is a new venture and the provision of food will be the principal source of sales revenue.

The application was notified in the Bay of Plenty Times on the 27th of March and the 3rd of April 2019 and no objections were received from members of the public.

The days and hours sought are **Monday to Sunday 10.00am to 11.00pm**. These hours are within with the Tauranga and Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy.

The applicant has provided a detailed menu of the food options they intend to sell and the low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments that are available.



The food is prepared on site and the inspector is satisfied that it is of an acceptable variety and price range and that a range of food offered can be provided within a reasonable time of placing an order.

A Building and Planning Certificate has been sought and issued showing the activity meets Town Planning requirements and those of the Building Code.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application has received supportive reports from the Inspector and the Police. The Medical Officer of Health also has no matters in opposition.

The inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area is unlikely to be adversely affected by more than a minor extent and that the applicant has sound host responsibility practices.

Sufficient certificated managers must be appointed to cover the intended opening hours.

The first year of a new licence is often called the 'probationary year' and no doubt the regulatory agencies will monitor the licence from time to time.


Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 & 106 of the Act.


The business is a low-risk restaurant/café. The current licensed hours are **Monday to Sunday 11.00am to 12 midnight**. The applicant seeks the earlier start time of 9.00am and has applied for, and received, an amended planning certificate authorising the extended hours.

These hours still fit within both the default national maximum trading hours and the Tauranga and Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy.

The application was publicly notified in the BOP Times on the 15th of March 2019 and no objections were received by the DLC Secretariat from members of the public.

We grant a waiver, under Section 208, as the public notice should have stated a variation of hours was being sought. We rule that the error is non-fatal to the application as the risk of alcohol related harm is still very low.

The applicant has provided comprehensive menus of the food options and low and non-alcoholic beverages available on the premises.



Reasons for the Decision

The applicant has operated this business for several years and has not come to notice in an adverse manner.

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health has any matters in opposition.

The inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area has not been adversely affected by more than a minor extent by this low risk activity.

The request for the earlier start is approved.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s120 & 131 of the Act.

Accordingly, I will determine the matter on the papers.



 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises;

 - c) A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the nominated person for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
8. No BYO alcohol is to be permitted to be brought in to the licensed area.

Amy Marie Seifert, on behalf of Pahoia School, applies for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises to be situated at 29 Esdaile Road, Pahoia.

The event is a fundraising Quiz Night and it is anticipated that there will be up to 200 people attending. Funds raised will be for the school projects.

The following day and hours are sought:

Friday the 28th of June 2019 6.30pm to 12 midnight.

The applicant has provided a detailed list of the food options and low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments that be provided along with free water for the duration of the event.

THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Inspector has provided a report on the application and believes that it meets the criteria for issue.



An exemption has been sought by the applicant under Section 213(2) of the Act to not have a certificated manager on duty. The exemption is supported by the Inspector. We are satisfied that a responsible person can effectively manage this event and an exemption is granted.

Neither the report of the Police nor of the Medical Officer of Health raises any matters in opposition.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.


DECISION

The District Licensing Committee, pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 grants the application by Amy Marie Seifert, on behalf of Pahoia School, for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises to be situated at 29 Esdaile Road, Pahoia" subject to conditions.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours:
Friday the 28th of June 2019 6.30pm to 12 midnight
2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. A person, nominated by the licensee to be responsible for the conduct of the premises, must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard.
5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic beverages.
6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:



- a) At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b) A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
 - c) A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the nominated person for the time being on duty.
7. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
8. No BYO alcohol is to be permitted to be brought in to the licensed area.
