Your rates invoice explained



Here is an example of a rates invoice and the key points and terminology to be aware of.

Solid waste charge

Charged per rating unit, these rates contribute to the cost of operating solid waste facilities in the eastern and western parts of the District, including recycling centres and ongoing work at closed landfills to ensure the environment is protected.

Kerbside rαte*

Covers the cost of Council's new kerbside recycling services.

The full service cost \$149 including GST (recycling, glass and food scraps collection).

The partial service cost is \$98 including GST (recycling and glass collections only).

*This is only charged to eligible households.

Water rates and metered water

Is a fixed charge that funds maintenance of water treatment plants, pumping stations and pipes.

There is a 'per cubic metre' volumetric charge that helps fund the delivery of safe, clean drinking water. This is invoiced separately from your rates invoice.

Units, Rate, and Annual \$

Units refer to what your charge is based on - it could be land value or capital value, or it could be a flat charge per property (Unit = 1).

Rate is the amount you pay per unit.

Annual \$ is equal to the 'Rate' multiplied by the 'Units' and is what you pay.

Due date

Payments after this date will incur a 10% penalty from the first instalment.

Valuation reference

Your valuation reference is your property's unique number, this should be quoted when making enquiries or payments.

Total amount for the year

This is the total rates due for the year (1 July 2022 - 30 June 2023).

Discount offered

Pay your rates in full, including any balances brought forward, before 5pm, Friday 23 September 2022 to receive a 3% discount.
