THE APPLICATION

This is an application by the **Matakana Island Recreation and Community Incorporated** for the renewal of a **Club Licence** in respect of premises situated at **178 Opureora Road, Matakana Island** known as the **Matakana Island Recreation and Community.**

The general nature of the business to be undertaken is that of a **Club Licence – Class 2.**

The applicant is an incorporated society, incorporated on 18 April 1990. This is the applicant's thirteenth application since 1994.

The application was publicly notified on the Western Bay of Plenty District website on 14 August 2024. The Inspector reports that while the publication of the licence renewal was made outside of the statutory timeframe, the public have not been disadvantaged by this minor omission. I agree, a waiver is granted under s.208 of the Act. No objections were received from members of the public within the prescribed time frame.

No changes are sought to the existing authorised hours which are:

Monday to Saturday 10:00 am to 1:00 am the following day
Sunday 10:00 am to 8:00 pm

These hours are within the operative Tauranga and Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy as it relates to Club Licences.

The applicant has supplied a list of food options as well as low and non-alcoholic beverages that are available when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.



The Medical Officer of Health originally opposed the application, but this was subsequently withdrawn on 31 January 2025. The Police have not reported on the application and pursuant to s.103(4) it is assumed that they have no matters in opposition.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The premises is primarily a recreation and sports club comprising a large open hall space with a veranda on two sides. There is a separate kitchen and small bar area. The applicant has requested a restricted designation for the club to apply after 8.00 pm. Given the nature of this club, I do not consider that such a designation is warranted without any evidence that would support it being applied. I agree with the Inspector that the club can, through their club rules, restrict access if so desired.

The licensed area is currently the entire inside of the premises. The applicant has requested, and the Inspector has supported, that a covered veranda area also be included under the licence. The licensed area, including the veranda, is more precisely identified on the plan date stamped as received by Western Bay of Plenty District Council on 23 July 2024.

The principal entrance is accessed from the carpark off Opureora Road, Matakana Island.

The applicant is not a member of NZCTA, where all member clubs share reciprocal rights.

The Inspector has reported that the renewal of this licence would not be in conflict with the object of the Act.

The Inspector has recommended that the section 60(1)(b) statement be included as item (d) in the first paragraph of the licence. I agree and that change will be reflected when the replacement licence is issued.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chair, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** the application by the **Matakana Island Recreation and Community Incorporated** for renewal of the Club-licence in respect of premises situated at **178 Opureora Road, Matakana Island** and known as the "**Matakana Island Recreation and Community**", subject to conditions.

Conditions

The licence is subject to the conditions listed as follows:

1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the following days and hours:

Monday to Saturday
Sunday

10:00 am to
10:00 am to

1:00 am the following day
8:00 pm



2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
3. **While the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, no BYO alcohol may be consumed on the premises.**
4. At all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol a range of substantive food must be readily available. A minimum of three types of food should be available on the premises. **Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.**
5. The Licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all time when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages (<2.5% abv).
6. The Licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
7. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering the premises.

The premises are as set out on the plans submitted with the application and date stamped 23 July 2025. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **MATAKANA ISLAND RECREATION AND COMMUNITY INCORPORATED SOCIETY** (the licensee) is authorised to sell and supply alcohol on the premises situated at **178 OPUREORA ROAD, MATAKANA ISLAND** and known as **MATAKANA ISLAND RECREATION AND COMMUNITY INCORPORATED** for consumption on the premises, to any person who –

- (a) is a member of the club; or
- (b) is on the premises at the invitation of, and is accompanied by, a member of the club; or

THE APPLICATION

This application, submitted by **HNM LIMITED**, a limited private company incorporated on 02 August 2023, seeks a renewal of an **OFF LICENCE** in respect of premises situated at **37 Main Road, Katikati**, a Bottle Store trading as **LIQUOR LAND KATIKATI**. The principal entrance to the premises is accessed via the store's carpark, located directly outside the store.

Hardeep (Harry) Singh Sani and Navdeep Singh are the two directors and equal shareholders of the applicant company. No issues or concerns have come to light regarding the directors.

This is the applicant's first renewal off-licence application for this premises. The applicant seeks no changes to the current conditions of the off-licence, nor changes to the licensed days or hours, which currently are Monday to Sunday: Hours: 9:00 am to 9:00 pm. The Local Alcohol Policy stipulates the maximum hours for an off-licence are: 7:00 am to 9:00 pm thereby they current hours comply with the Local Alcohol Policy.

The criteria found at section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) applies to this application.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

An off-licence may be renewed for this kind of premises because it meets the description found at section 32(1)(b) of the Act.

The application was publicly notified on the Western Bay of Plenty District Council website. No public objections have been received.

The Police when reporting on the application on 14 December 2024 did not oppose the application.

The MOH reported on the application on 03 December 2024 and were unopposed to the application but have offered the following recommendation: *that the sale of high strength*



beers in 500mls and over be sold for no less than \$6 per can and/or be bundled into packs of 2 or 4.

Thereby no concerns regarding the applicant's suitability or the current operation of the premise has been raised by the reporting agencies.

The Inspector reports she conversed with Paramjeet Singh in December 2024, whilst completing an inspection of the premises and states that Paramjeet Singh appeared to understand their responsibilities under the Act. She also reports that she considers the applicant to be suitable and their proposal for the sale and supply of alcohol is consistent with the Act's purpose and meets the section 131 criteria. Thereby she does not oppose this application and has no concerns with the applicant's suitability.

The most recent annual sales figures provided by the applicant indicate that 94.9% of the annual sales revenue is derived from the sale of alcohol.

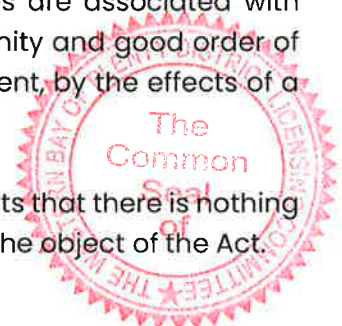
There have been no issues raised regarding the Building Code or the Resource Management Act. FENZ has reported with no opposition to the granting of a renewed Licence.

The Inspector reports that the premises has a generic bottle store layout with entire premises designated as supervised as the principal purpose of business is the sale of alcohol. No changes have been made to the licensed area, thereby the entire premise is licensed as per the scale plan submitted with the application date stamped 24 March 2025. When an inspection was conducted all the required signage was correctly displayed, including the duty manager's name and the applicant appeared to have the appropriate systems, staff, and training in place to comply with the law. Therefore, there appears to be no concerns with the design and layout of the premises.

Alongside alcohol the applicant sells tobacco products and ready to eat snacks.

The premises is commercially zoned and situated near the Katikati town centre on State Highway 2 (Main Road). There are several licensed premises in near proximity within the town centre. There are two licensed premises within 100 metres of the store; Katikati Four Square (which is adjacent to the premises) and Super Liquor Katikati. There is a liquor ban in place which covers the entire town of Katikati, meaning the consumption of alcohol (except in a licensed premises) is prohibited in a public place. The premises is well kept and has a tidy appearance within the building and from the outside. No complaints have been received from neighbouring residents or businesses regarding the store's operations. There are no negative reports from the police and no visual signs of crime in the local vicinity. There is no information to suggest the premises are associated with criminal behaviour. Thereby there is no reason to believe the amenity and good order of the locality would likely to be increased, by more than a minor extent, by the effects of a refusal to renew the licence.

Standing back and considering this application, the Inspector reports that there is nothing to suggest that the granting of this application would not achieve the object of the Act.

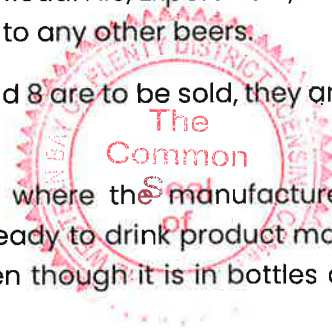


THE DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairperson, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, thereby issues **HNM LIMITED**, a renewed **OFF LICENCE** in respect of premises a Bottle Store trading as **LIQUOR LAND KATIKATI** from **37 Main Road, Katikati**, subject to the following conditions be applied.

The Conditions to be Applied at all times.

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:
Monday to Sunday: 9.00am to 9.00pm
2. No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
3. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
4. **The licensed area is designated as supervised.**
5. A properly appointed Certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
6. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.
7. The licensed premises are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Western Bay of Plenty District Licensing Committee on **24 March 2025**.
8. There shall be no display or sale of single bottles of mainstream beers where the volume is 330ml or less and not intended by the manufacturer to be sold as a single item. The mainstream beers to which this condition relates are named as follows: Lion Red, Waikato Draught, Speights Gold Medal Ale, Export Gold, and Tui East India Pale Ale. This condition does not apply to any other beers.
9. Where items of products classified in conditions 7 and 8 are to be sold, they are to be sold as multiples.
10. For the avoidance of doubt, craft beers or items where the manufacturer classifies the item as a craft beer or cider or craft ready to drink product may be displayed for sale and sold as a single item even though it is in bottles or cans of 330 ml or less.



Please note a change required.

11. It is noted that Condition 5 of the current off-licence (022/OFF/9137/2024) mentions non and low-alcohol beverages being available for **consumption on** the premises. The DLC's seeks this condition to be remove from the renewed Licence so that the new Off Licence aligns with the standard conditions for an off-licence-Bottle Store.

It is noted that his Visa has a 14th March 2029 expiry date – outside the term of an initial Certificate.

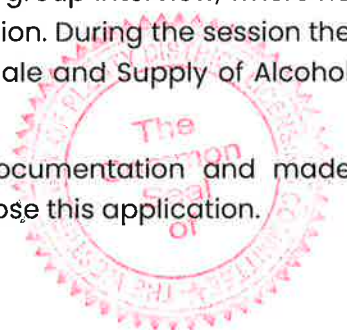
THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION
