The Application

This is an application by **Jayson Holdings Limited** for the renewal and variation of an
OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 137 Jellicoe Street, Te Puke, known as "**Te
Puke Four Square & Lotto**."

The applicant has been operating this store for nearly 8 years.

The current days and hours are: **Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 9.00pm. No changes
are sought.**

These are within the default national maximum trading hours for off licences of 7am to
11pm and within the adopted Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy.

The business is a medium-sized open-plan store with shelves and aisles holding food
products and other household goods on all sides and a single alcohol area (SAA) in
one corner of the store.

The application was notified on councils website from the 19th of May 2025 and no
objections were received from members of the public.



The applicant has submitted sales figures for the 12 months period immediately prior to lodging the application that indicate that the principal activity is the sale of food products.

The Police do not oppose the renewal. The Medical Officer of Health initially opposed the renewal believing the SSA was too visible and that 500ml cans should only be sold in 4-packs.

That opposition is now withdrawn but the recommendations remain.

The applicant has identified a revised SAA as per the plan dated 13 November 2025 and asks the DLC to endorse the new layout.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contains all the necessary considerations as required under s.127 of the Act. It was duly advertised, and no public objections were received.

The agencies appear to be satisfied that this business is a grocery store and that the amenity and good order of the area has not been reduced by more than a minor extent.

Subject to the above the Committee is satisfied that the business is that of a grocery store.

The plan to redefine the SAA is approved.

The directors have signed up to the new Community Response Plan drawn up with the agencies and ask that the discretionary conditions attached to this licence be modified to reflect this new commitment.

We have considered the request and agree to the modification.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.120 and 131 and s.112-115 of the Act.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.



DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by **Jayson Holdings Limited** for the renewal and variation of an OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 137 Jellicoe Street, Te Puke, known as "Te Puke Four Square & Lotto" subject to conditions.

We also refresh the licence conditions to reflect best practice.

Conditions:

The licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, and supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours: **Monday to Sunday 7.00am to 10.00pm;**
2. No alcohol is to be sold on, or delivered from, the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day;
3. No alcohol may be sold other than –
 - a. beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - b. mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - c. fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - d. grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - e. a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted;
4. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons at no cost from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
5. A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty, at or nearby the point of sale, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. **There is to be no single sales of mainstream beers under 500mls and/or those not intended by the manufacturer to be sold as single serves.**



7. **The licensee agrees to comply with the Te Puke Community Response Plan (CRP) and consents to display a signed copy prominently next to the licence.**
8. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
- At every point of sale signage detailing the restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance to the premises; and
 - A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
9. The "single alcohol area" for the premises is as described on the plan dated **13 November 2025** and attached at Appendix 'A' to the licence. The licensee must ensure that:
- No alcohol is displayed, promoted or advertised outside the single alcohol area; and
 - No products other than alcohol, low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beer, wine or mead are displayed, promoted or advertised inside the single alcohol area.

Off Licence Renewal

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **JAYSON HOLDINGS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **137 JELICOE STREET, TE PUKE** and known as **TE PUKE FOUR SQUARE & LOTTO**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

 - a. beer that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for beer; or
 - b. mead that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for mead; or
 - c. fruit or vegetable wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for fruit or vegetable wine; or
 - d. grape wine that complies with the appropriate New Zealand food standard for grape wine; or
 - e. a food flavouring, prepared for culinary purposes, that is unsuitable for drinking undiluted;
4. While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons at no cost from a water supply prominently situated on the premises;
5. A properly appointed Certificated, or Acting or Temporary, Manager must be on duty, at or nearby the point of sale, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol.
6. **There is to be no single sales of mainstream beers under 500mls and/or those not intended by the manufacturer to be sold as single serves.**
7. **The licensee agrees to comply with the Te Puke Community Response Plan (CRP) and consents to display a signed copy prominently next to the licence.**
8. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale signage detailing the restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance to the premises; and
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
9. The "single alcohol area" for the premises is as described on the plan dated **13 November 2025** and attached at Appendix 'A' to the licence. The licensee must ensure that:
 - a. No alcohol is displayed, promoted or advertised outside the single alcohol area; and
 - b. No products other than alcohol, low-alcohol and non-alcoholic beer, wine or mead are displayed, promoted or advertised inside the single alcohol area.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence replaces licence no. 022/RENOFF/8575/2022 and this licence continues in force until 20 June 2028 unless again renewed.

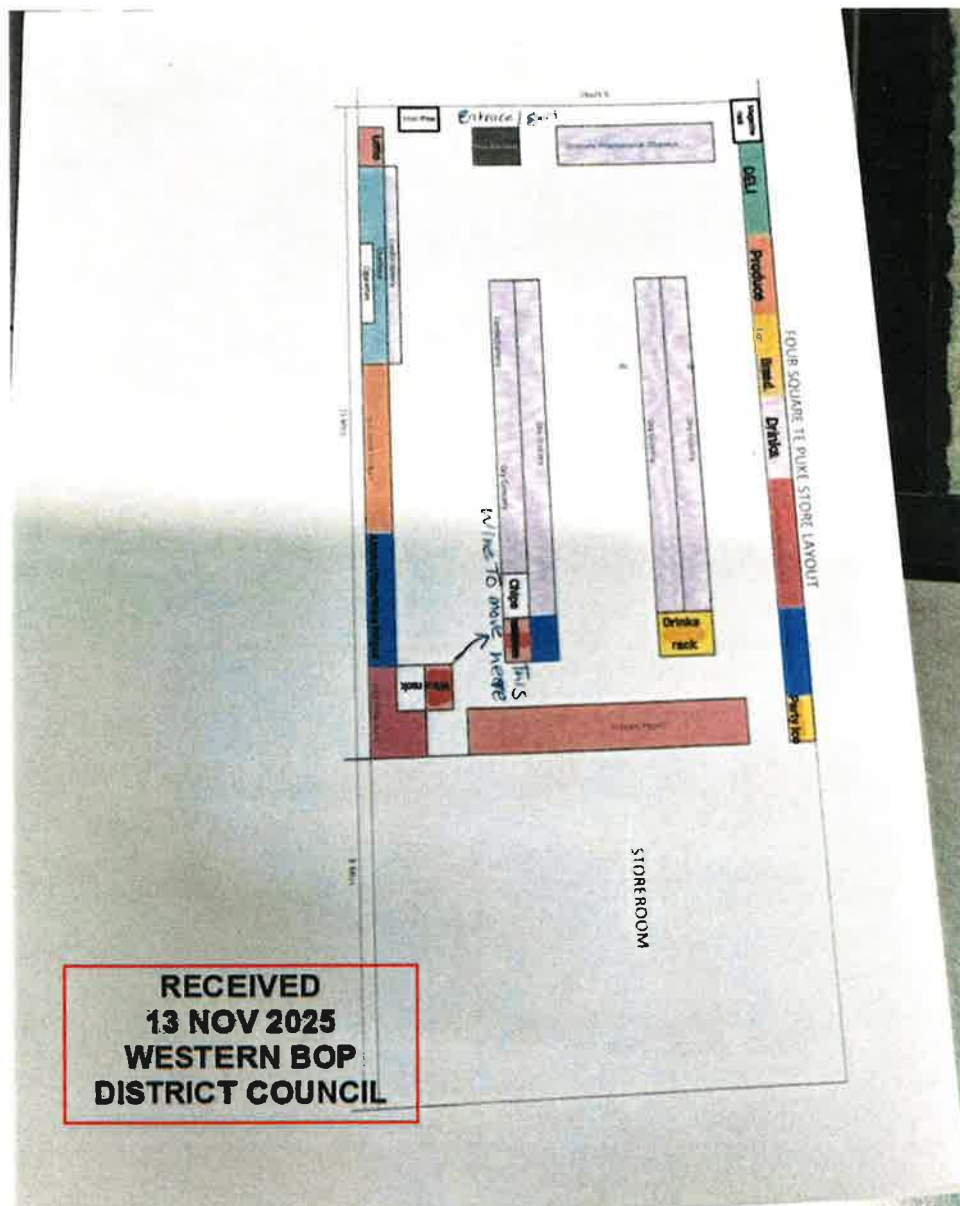

The Application

Sandnadlay Limited applies for the renewal of the ON Licence in respect of premises situated at 7 Clarke Road, Te Puna known as "Clarke Road Kitchen."

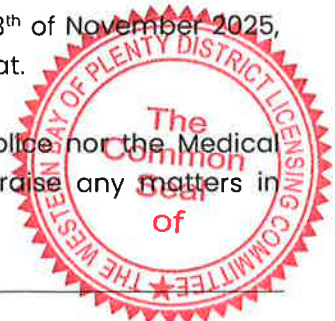
The general nature of the business is that of a restaurant/café and a Section 38 endorsement is in place as the applicant also has an off-site catering business.

The current days and hours of operation are **Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 7.00pm for home based on-site consumption; and 9.00am to 1.00am the following day off-site consumption when catering off-site.** These hours are within the default national maximum trading hours for an on licence of 8am to 4am.

They have provided extensive off-site catering menus and evidence of carrying out the business of a caterer.

The application was publicly notified in the BOP Times on the 28th of November 2025, and no objections were received from the public by the secretariat.

The Inspector does not oppose this application. Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health (no report within the statutory time frame) raise any matters in opposition to this application.



REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has been an experienced hospitality operator for many years and has provided acceptable menus together with a list of both low and non-alcoholic refreshments that satisfy the requirements of the Act.

Experienced certificated managers must be employed to oversee the sale and supply of alcohol at home base and away at catered functions.

The Inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area has not been reduced by more than a minor extent.

In regard to the ongoing request for a caterer's endorsement the Committee is satisfied that the applicant does carry on the business of a caterer. The Section 38 endorsed ON Licence will be approved on conditions.

I am also satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act.

Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **approves** an application by **Sandnaday Limited** for the renewal of the ON Licence in respect of premises situated at 7 Clarke Road, Te Puna known as "Clarke Road Kitchen" subject to conditions.

The premises are as set out on the plan submitted with the application and date stamped 18 November 2025.

The Licence shall be endorsed "Section 38 applies".

Conditions:

The following conditions apply at the **home base premises and at any catering premises:**

1. Alcohol may be sold and supplied at the home base premises and sold at the catering premises for consumption at those premises on the following days



and hours: **Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 7.00pm home base on-site consumption; 9.00am to 1.00am the following day off-site consumption when catering off-site;**

2. No alcohol is to be sold or supplied on the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1pm on Anzac Day to any person other than a person who is on the premises to dine;
3. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
4. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages.
5. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard. Menus must be visible, and food should be actively promoted.
6. **A properly appointed certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.**
7. The licensee must provide information, advice and assistance about alternative forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
8. The licensee must display at every point of sale signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.

The following condition applies only at the home base premises:

9. The licensee must display:
 - a. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering the principal entrance.



The Licence is renewed for three (3) years from the expiry of the current licence, and a Replacement Licence is to be issued.

(with sales ceasing at 10:30 pm, allowing for a 30-minute drink up time)

3. The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when alcohol may be sold and supplied under the licence, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments, low alcoholic beverages (<2.5%) and food specified in the application.
4. Information regarding and assistance with alternative forms of transport must be available.
5. For the purposes of the licence **Justin Lawrence BRUNING** has been appointed to manage the sale and consumption of alcohol, and to ensure the compliance with the provisions of Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012.
6. A maximum of two (standard) alcoholic drinks per person per transaction is permitted.
7. The following steps must be taken to ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed:
 - a. Ensure that no intoxicated persons are allowed to enter or to remain on the premises.
8. The licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signage detailing restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons.
 - b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises.
 - c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises that identifies by name the certificated manager on duty.
9. **No BYO permitted.**
