The Application

Amit Kooner Limited applies for renewal of an OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 155A Jellicoe Street, Te Puke known as "Te Puke Liquor Centre."

The business is a franchised bottle store and meets the criteria of s.32(1)(b) of the Act in that it is retail premises from which more than 85% of the annual sales revenue is earned from the sale of alcohol for consumption somewhere else.

The entire premises is designated as a Supervised Area.

The current days and hours of operation are: **Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm.** These hours are within the default national maximum trading hours and the new Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy as it pertains to off-licensed bottle stores. No changes are sought.

Public Notification:

The application was notified in the on council's website from the 23rd of January 2025. No objections from the public were received by the secretariat.



REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The Inspector reports that the applicant appears to have operated **this bottle store** compliantly over the renewal period.

Neither the Police, nor the Medical Officer of Health, have reported on the renewal within the statutory timeframe and we assume that they are unopposed

The Inspector notes that the Sukhpal Singh, director of the company has been involved in 3 closures of on licensed premises in recent years but have no adverse findings in off-licensed premises other than an infringement notice on 3 October 2025 after the duty manager was found next door at the Vape Shop.

The directors have signed up to a new Community Response Plan drawn up with the agencies and ask that the discretionary conditions attached to this licence be modified to reflect this new commitment.

We have considered the request and agree to the modification.

Subject to the above, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act.

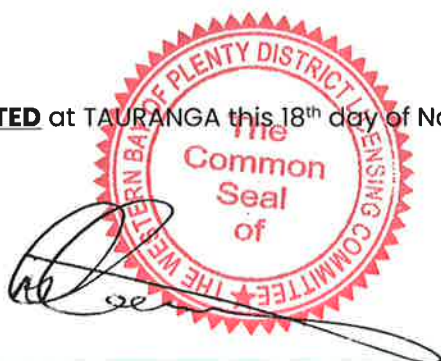

9. The Licensee must display:
- At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;

The Application

Thiara Liquor Limited applies for the renewal of the OFF Licence in respect of premises situated at 161 Jellicoe Street, Te Puke known as "Thirsty Liquor Te Puke."

The business is a franchised bottle store and must meet the criteria of s.32(1)(b) of the Act in that it is retail premises from which more than 85% of the annual sales revenue is earned from the sale of alcohol for consumption somewhere else. The Inspector reports that the sales from this store are just under the 85%.

The licensee must ensure that other products are not promoted to the point where they make up more than 15% of sales.

The entire premises is designated as a Supervised Area.

The current days and hours are: **Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm. No Changes are sought.**

These hours are within the default national maximum trading hours and are within the newly adopted Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy as it pertains to off-licensed bottle stores.



Public Notification:

The application was notified on council's website from the 27th of February 2025. No objections from the public were received by the secretariat.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

Neither the Police, nor the Medical Officer of Health (no report within the statutory timeframes), raise any matters in opposition.

The Inspector reports that the owners have been operating compliantly during the renewal period.

The licensee has agreed to comply with the Te Puke Community Response Plan (CRP) and consents to displaying a signed copy of the Plan prominently next to the licence.

We have agreed to modify the current conditions to reflect the provisions of the CRP.

Subject to the above, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act.
