

  - (a) the sale, supply, and consumption of alcohol should be undertaken safely and responsibly; and
  - (b) the harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol should be minimised.
- (2) For the purposes of subsection (1), the harm caused by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol includes—
  - (a) any crime, damage, death, disease, disorderly behaviour, illness, or injury, directly or indirectly caused, or directly or indirectly contributed to, by the excessive or inappropriate consumption of alcohol; and
  - (b) any harm to society generally or the community, directly or indirectly caused, or directly or indirectly contributed to, by any crime, damage, death, disease, disorderly behaviour, illness, or injury of a kind described in paragraph (a).

This questionnaire helps ensure that licensees meet the requirements of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 in relation to the public health consequences of alcohol use, such as alcohol- related health problems and preventable death or disability from alcohol-related motor vehicle crashes.

This questionnaire will enable the completion of the Medical Officer of Health report on you licence application. Your licence application cannot be processed without completion of this questionnaire.







Hi Gagan,

With the respect to our meeting on Monday 28 May 2018 please find the following items that were discussed.

- The public notices for the on-licence renewal and variation application have been published in The Bay of Plenty Times on Saturday 26 May 2018 and to be published on Saturday 2 June 2018.
- The public notices will have to be published again as there is not mention of the variation to extend the licensed area into the car park. The Katikati Advertiser would possibly be a more local and cheaper option.
- 3. You also spoke to VJ, the environmental Health officer with respect to your dishwasher.
- 4. In order to extend the licensed area into the car park, the planning department have stated you will need to be granted a resource consent to enable you to do so. I have given you the application form in order to apply for the resource consent. My advice would be to speak to a consultant.
- 5. I asked about Robyn's letter. However you have stated such a letter is with yourself and you did not produce it.
- 6. Noise from now on I will advise for the 'out of hours' watchdog team to monitor any noise complaints so they can have an objective view. It is your responsibility to ensure your noise levels comply with the district plan. I suggest you speak to a duty planner with respect to the acceptable noise levels you are permitted to emit from your premises and how to measure them.
- 7. You will also require a letter of authorisation from your partner to act on his behalf as he is the director or ask him to make you a director of the business.
- You asked that I contact you should I receive any noise complaints so you can act immediately and rectify the situation. Under the circumstances I must refer you to point 6.
- 9. I will contact you after 6 June 2018 with respect to your manager's certificate interview. I met the Police and MOH yesterday the Police have reported on your application and highlighted the fact that the defined area of the extension of the licensed area needs to be clearly defined with a physical barrier and the extended area should only be licensed until 9.00 pm. I haven't received the MOH report yet, but I am almost certain it will request the same conditions.

Until your resource consent is granted, the application will have to be put on hold, meaning you cannot use the outside area as you intended until such time a new licence is granted to do so. May I suggest you give attention to the requirements as stated by the Police. I am

inclined to agree. Should you disagree the application will go to a hearing for the DLC to consider everyone's points of view.

I have also been notified of the intended Te Puna by-pass works that are to be programed in for the near future. I was unaware that the by-pass has been designed to go through your premises as well as the Black Sheep. I do not have a time scale for this. Are you aware? Warmest regards

The Sandhu Bar is situated in a rural location directly off the main highway on Plummers Point road OMOKOROA. Due to the physical distance from both Katikati and Tauranga (at least 20 to 30 minutes' drive from both stations) the ability for Police to conduct hotel compliance checks is restricted. The premises is therefore not checked by Police as often as other licenced premises so there is a need to ensure that there is strong management connected with the premises to minimise risk.

There have been no calls for service for Police to attend at the premises however this may be due to the problems being handled locally due to the knowledge that Police will take some time to attend.

The applicant wishes to extend the licenced area by two metres into the carpark. Police would like to highlight that there needs to be a defined area to ensure there is a physical barrier to show what is licenced and what is not. The interest of neighbouring residents (across the road) need to be considered and if there is a decision to grant the extension then Police respectfully ask that this extended area is only licenced until 9 pm



#### 1. APPLICATION DESCRIPTION

#### 1.1 Application and Property Details

#### 2. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This is a report on an application for a renewal of an on-licence. The criteria found at section 131 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act) applies to this application.

The applicant does not seek any changes to the licence. The initial application requested an increase to the licensed area into the car park. The applicant has since changed their mind and decided not to continue with the increase of the licensed area and remain with the status quo.

There is one public objection. Neither of the reporting agencies have opposed this application; however, after due consideration I oppose this application.





#### 3. APPLICANT AND APPLICATION

#### 3.1 Applicant

The applicant is private limited company and was incorporated on 11 February 2014.

Gurinderpal Singh took over as the director of the business on 9 July 2014.

Gagan Deep Singh took over as a 50% shareholder on 10 August 2014, but is not a director.

Gurinderpal Singh has provided a written consent for Gagan Deep Singh to act on his behalf.

The question of suitability has been raised with respect to the overall management of the tavern. There have been complaints over noise, patrons drinking after hours and the questionable actions of duty managers, which have resulted in upsetting residents.

Taverns by their very nature tend to lean towards the risker side of drinking establishments. The principal purpose is the sale and consumption of alcohol. Tighter controls are expected of such establishments with respect to the staff and visiting patrons in order to maintain a harmonious environment with the neighbouring properties.

#### 3.2 Comment

I have to raise the question of suitability with respect to the management and control of the business.

#### 4. OBJECTIONS AND EXTERNAL REPORTS

#### 4.1 Public Notice

The application was publicly notified in the Bay of Plenty Times on the following dates:

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#### 4.2 Objections

There is one objection received from Donna and Philip Cox on 8 June 2018.

Donna and Philip Cox object to the renewal of the on-licence for Sandhu 2014 Ltd due to:

- 1. Excessive noise on many occasions from music, unruly patrons and cars.
- 2. Patrons being left alone to drink and play music until all hours.
- Two unsolicited visits to the home address of the objector by the duty manager of Sandhu Bar on a mission to find out who has been complaining about them. The second visit was to persuade the objector to sign a document to state they had no problem with the bar.

The objectors wish to appear and be heard at a hearing.

Donna and Philip Cox reside at 14 Albert Lane, Plummers Point, which on a direct path is approximately 50 metres across the road from the Sandhu Bar.

I have attached an aerial view of the objector's property in relation to the Sandhu Bar with this report.

#### 4.3 Police Report

Police reported on the application on 30 May 2018. That report does not oppose the application, but due to its rural location have stated the need for strong management to minimise risk. The report continues to state that should an extended licensed area be granted then consideration should be given to restricting the hours for the outside licensed area to 9.00 pm in the interest of neighbouring residents.

It should be noted that the applicant has decided not to continue with the extension to the outside licensed area.

#### 4.4 Medical Officer of Health Report

The Medical Officer of Health has not reported on the application. As per section 103(4), if the Medical Officer of Health does report within 15 working days, the licensing committee may assume the Medical Officer of Health has no matters in opposition.

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#### 5. PREMISES

#### 5.1 Principal Entrance

The principal entrance is accessed from: Car parking off Plummers Point Road, Omokoroa.

#### 5.2 Planning and Building Matters

There have been no issues raised in regards to the building code or the Resource Management Act 1991. This is essentially down to the fact the applicant has retracted the request for an extension to the licensed area. Had the applicant continued to press forward with the original request of extending the licensed area, they would have had to apply for a resource consent as the new layout plan attached to the alcohol licence would not comply with the resource consents that have been approved in the past.

#### 5.3 Previous History

Since December 2017 several concerns have come to light regarding the management of the Sandhu Bar. The initial concerns were noise complaints back in December 2017 from residents. These noise complaints raised further concerns with how the duty manager was managing the bar. The duty manager has since left after his duty manager's certificate application was declined by the DLC. Further information came to light to indicate the bar was not offering food as required by the Act. A graduated response meeting was held in January 2018 with the Gagan Deep Kaur to rectify these matters.

#### 5.4 Site Inspection

I visited the premises on Thursday 24 May 2018 at approximately 2.40 pm and Friday 13 July 2018 at approximately 1.20 pm.

On both occasions I found that all required signage was clearly displayed, including the host responsibility policy. An air-fryer and frozen food were available to utilise and cook. Low and non-alcoholic beverages were readily available. Taxi information is available. There was no concerns at the time for excessive noise or overcrowding as there were no customers present at those times. However it was noted that there are external speakers for the outside smoking area. The duty manager was present with their name prominently displayed.

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#### 5.5 Comment

I do not oppose the present design and layout of the premises.

Even though the inspections were positive with respect to the necessary requirements as stipulated under the Act, there have been a series of incidents that should be noted since December 2017.

Subsequently, it is questionable whether the applicant has had the necessary control over the day to day management of the tavern.

The series of incidents would possibly suggest the applicant has not had the most appropriate systems, staff, or training to comply with the law.

The manner in which the applicant has sold, displayed, advertised or promoted alcohol has not caused concern for the reporting agencies.

#### 6. ENVIRONMENTAL SCAN

#### 6.1 Current and Potential Levels of Noise, Nuisance and Vandalism

There are no negative reports from the police and no visual signs of crime in the local vicinity. There is no information to suggest the premises are associated with criminal behaviour.

Vandalism is not an identifiable concern in the locality.

There have been noise complaints and allegations of the car park being used by patrons after the bar has closed. These concerns were initially raised with the licensee at a GRM meeting, who resolved to immediately rectify the concerns.

#### 6.2 Comment

There is a strong possibility that the amenity and good order of the locality would more than likely be increased, to far more than a minor extent, by the effects of the refusal to renew the licence.

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#### 7. CONCLUSION AND CONDITIONS

#### 7.1 Conclusion

I have inquired into the application, and based on the information provided I oppose this application for the renewal of an on-licence.
