

Off Licence Renewal

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **SH HOLDING 2021 LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **17A MINDEN ROAD, TE PUNA** and known as **TE PUNA LIQUOR CENTRE**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol may be sold on, or delivered from, the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm

5. **A properly appointed Certificated or Acting or Temporary Manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.**
6. **The whole of the premises is designated as a Supervised Area.**
7. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or

The Application

The applicant has recently completed their first full year of trading.

The business is a franchised bottle store and meets the criteria of s.32(1)(b) of the Act in that it is retail premises from which more than 85% of the annual sales revenue is earned from the sale of alcohol for consumption somewhere else.

The entire premises is to be designated as a Supervised Area.

The current days and hours are **Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm.**

No Changes Are sought.

These hours are within the default national maximum trading hours and the operative Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy as it pertains to off-licensed bottle stores.



Public Notification:

The application was notified in the Te Puke Times on the 25th of October and the 1st of November 2023. No objections from the public were received by the secretariat.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

We deem that the Police and the Medical Officer of Health have no matters in opposition as they have not reported within the statutory parameters.

It appears that the amenity and good order of the area has not been reduced by more than a minor extent.

Accordingly, I consider the application on the papers.

6. **The whole of the premises is designated as a Supervised Area.**
7. The Licensee must display:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people immediately outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for sale of alcohol;

The licence is to be endorsed "**Section 40 applies**".

THE APPLICATION

This is an application by **Ditto Company Limited** for renewal of an **Off licence** in respect of premises situated at **656E Minden Road, Tauranga**, known as **Distillerie Deinlein**.

The general nature of the business is that of a boutique manufacturer of spirits and liqueurs mainly for other companies. The **off-licence endorsed under section 40** of the Act, is required as the company also sells to the public via the internet.

The applicant is a limited private company incorporated on 7 March 1994. Irmengard Annamarie Luise Deinlein, Michael Deinlein and Tobias Deinlein are the shareholders/directors. This is the applicant's ninth renewal application having traded since 2001.

Public Notification

The application was publicly notified in the Weekend Sun version of the Bay of Plenty Times on the 17th of November 2023. No objections to the application were received by the secretariat.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The application is complete and contains all the required supporting documents as required under section 127 of the Act.

The Police have reported on the application and offer no matters in opposition. The Medical Officer of Health has not reported on the application therefore, pursuant to s.103(4) of the Act it can be assumed that there are no matters in opposition.

Section 214 of the Act requires that a certificated manager be on duty at all times unless section 215 applies. Section 215 provides a range of exceptions where a manager does not



have to be on duty and on of them is for premises endorsed under section 40 as remote sellers.

While a licensee must have a certificated manager properly appointed, that manager does not need to be always physically present and on duty. In the present situation Irmengard Annamarie Luise Deinlein is the holder of a general manager's certificate.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.131 of the Act and that the applicant is carrying out the business as a remote seller of alcohol.

DECISION


