THE REASONS FOR THE DECISION

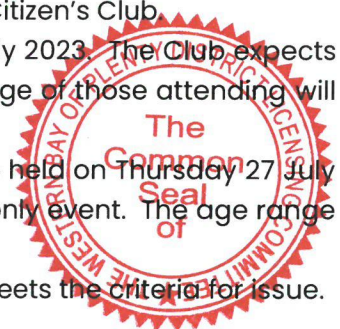

The Club expects that about 90 persons will attend this invitation only event. The age range of those attending will be between 20 to 90 years.

The second event is for the Eastpack Kiwifruit Company Quiz night to be held on Thursday 27 July 2023. The Club expects that up to 60 persons will attend this invitation only event. The age range of those attending will also be between 20 to 70 years.

The Inspector has provided a report and believes that the application meets the criteria for issue.

For the purpose of the event, **Tracey Louise MOUAT** has been appointed to manage the conduct of the sale of alcohol and ensure compliance with the Act. The Medical Officer of Health has raised no matters in opposition. The Police have not reported on the application. Pursuant to s.141(5) of the Act it can be assumed that the Police have no matters in opposition.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

The Application

This business will be that of a Class 3 restaurant and the provision of food will be the principal source of sales revenue.

The application was notified in the Katikati Advertiser on the on the 29th of June and the 6th of July 2023 and no objections were received from members of the public.

The days and hours sought are **Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 12.00 midnight.** These days and hours are within the Western Bay of Plenty Local Alcohol Policy.

If they wish to open earlier for food and coffee that is a matter for them to decide.

The applicant has provided a detailed menu of the food options they sell and the low alcohol and non-alcoholic refreshments that are available.

A Building and Planning Certificate has been sought and issued showing the activity meets Town Planning requirements and the Building Code.



REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has only one certificated manager attached to the business at this time, but more are to be appointed.

The applicant has received supportive reports from the Inspector and the Police. The Medical Officer of Health also has no matters in opposition.

The inspector reports that the amenity and good order of the area is unlikely to be reduced by more than a minor extent and that the applicant has sound host responsibility practices.

The first year of a new licence is often called the 'probationary year' and we expect the regulatory agencies to monitor the licence closely.

Overall, I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.105 & 106 of the Act.

We consider the application on the papers.
